Fowler Athletics Fans,

Thank you for your continued support of Fowler Athletics, even in these challenging times. As I am sure you are aware, all MHSAA post-season tickets will be sold ONLINE ONLY this year using GoFan as mandated by the MHSAA. The standard process will be I send a link out to parents for them to buy the limited tickets first, then open it up to the community 24-48 hours later. We are in the midst of this process for the first time currently for tomorrow night's football game, and so far it seems to be going well.

The next part in this process is what happens at the admission gate, and I wanted to give some general directions on this. After making your purchase, you can access your tickets through your email or the GoFan website/app. When arriving at the venue, you need to pull the link to your tickets up on your phone. You will click the check boxes next to the tickets you want to "validate" or use. Once you get up to the admission person, you show them your phone and click the validate button. A green check mark appears letting the "ticket taker" know your tickets have been paid for and they can not be used by someone else. That's it!

We understand this is a new process, and there will surely be some initial struggles, but the more people that we can have prepared and ready to go, the faster the line will go. Below I have included the link to a couple 1 minute tutorial videos that will help you understand the process.
