

FPS Food Service Charging Policy

Effective 11/13/17

Fowler Schools Food Service staff appreciate the opportunity to provide healthy, balanced lunches to our students each day. As with all of our school programs, we succeed in this goal when we all work together to sustain the program and make lunches affordable and nutritious without detracting from our other educational goals. For this reason, it is important that our food service program be self-supporting financially.

Families can put money on their student's account or pay balances through Meal Magic's Family Portal. To both meet the state requirement and to assure a fair process for our students and families, we instituted the following policy in the event an account becomes delinquent.

Waldron Elementary and Middle School

Outstanding balances of **\$5.00** or more will receive electronic email messages daily and a written letter weekly. Once a student lunch balance reaches **\$10.00**, a phone call will be made to the parent, in addition to the electronic messages.

If the outstanding balance reaches **\$20.00**, the student will receive an alternative lunch. This lunch will consist of a cheese sandwich, apple and a white milk. The student will continue to receive this meal until the outstanding balance is below \$20.00

Fowler High School

Outstanding balances of **\$5.00** or more will receive electronic email messages daily and a written letter weekly. Once a student lunch balance reaches **\$10.00**, a phone call will be made to the parent, in addition to the electronic messages.

If the outstanding balance reaches **\$20.00**, the student will not be allowed to charge to the account any longer, and should see the school principal to borrow money for a lunch until the outstanding balance is below \$20.00.
